

„PHODAR” BIENNIAL 2009 REGULATIONS

1. „PHODAR” Foundation, under the guidance of the Mayor of the Pleven Municipality, organizes the Sixth „PHODAR” Biennial under the motto CHANCE ENCOUNTERS. The Salon is open for authors from all over the world.
2. We accept monochrome and colour works from 25 to 50 cm one side, without carton board and unframed. Works which appeared at the previous editions of the Salon will not be accepted.

The Biennial accepts media products - installations based mainly upon a photographic image as an information bearer. Installations must be adapted for presentation on paper, dimensions conforming to the regulations, videocassette or CD, with actual dimensions denoted. Approved and awarded projects should be exposed within the frames of the Biennial.

All photos entered for the competition and the information about them, author's photo and a CV, should also be sent on a CD or DVD (the images in TIF or JPG format, size-10/15 cm, 300 dpi) in order to be included in the catalogue.

3. At the backside of each work, bottom right, please indicate:
The title of the work, year of production, the address and the name of the author, country, number of the work and scheme of order for exhibiting of series and cycles.

4. Works to be sent to:

as a registered postage without a declared value.

Please write the sender's address on each packing to make things easier when sending them back.

Installations transport fees are covered (in both directions) by the author.

In connection with the change of the post fee, the authors, who send the post fee for shipping back works: for parcels with weigh

under 2 kg – 20 Euro for parcel

under 4 kg – 25 Euro for parcel

under 5 kg – 30 Euro for parcel

or stamped international postage coupons for the same sum,

will receive their works according to the Calendar of the Salon.

The organizers don't assume responsibility for loss or blasting of the photographs on the time of the transport.

5. The works will compete in the following areas:

1st area includes dossier of 5-12 photographs with a coherent sounding message.

2nd area is for individual works.

3rd area -Photoschool- is for authors who are still studying or at the beginning of their career. The above requirements are valid for them, but at the back of each work they have to write -Photoschool-

6. Each photographer can participate in:

1st area - with 1 dossier

2nd area - up to 5 works

or

3rd area - with 1 dossier and 5 separate works

7. The organizers keep their right to copy the works received for the purposes of the Salon's announcement.

8. Collective participants /clubs, photography societies, associations and other/ receive free catalogue. Everyone can buy catalogue at the cost of 5 Euro. Bank transfers and cheques are not accepted.

Additional prizes from different companies (objects).
